GENERAL INFORMATION

Club Fiscal Year: November 1st to October 31st Membership Year: January 1st to December 31st

Age: January 1st in the year for which the membership is sought.

House Minimum: Includes all dining room and snack bar purchases but does not include HST or gratuity. House minimum is for the period of October 1st to September 30th.

Initiation: A financial obligation assumed at the time of acceptance for membership. All new and some existing members (based on their current membership status) will have this financial obligation. Initiation may be paid over a period of up to five years with an annual surcharge of 2%. New members must be approved by the Board of Directors before membership is granted and playing privileges begin.

As of November 1st, 2023, the initiation fee is \$7,000. For members joining within the Couples category, this will amount to a total initiation fee of \$8,400 with the additional 20% (\$1,400) being allocated to the spouse.

Current members turning 37, will receive a 10% credit, per year of continuous membership at the Club, up to 90% of the initiation fee at the time they turn 37. All Intermediate and Young Adult members, as of October 31st, 2021, are grandfathered, and are subject to the initiation fee (minimum 10%) upon the year of their 37th birthday.

Spouse: A couple who are married to each other or are not married to each other and have cohabited continuously for a period of not less than one year and or have a child of the relationship, or same-sex partners who have cohabited continuously for a period of not less than one year.

Dependents: Dependent children of principal playing members and if applicable, his/her spouse.

Continuity: An unbroken series of yearly continuous memberships.

Resignation: Members who fail to declare their intention to resign by March 1st of the membership year are responsible for payment of dues.

Arrears Policy: A 2% per month - 24% per year surcharge will be levied on all account balances over 30 days in arrears. Accounts over 60 days in arrears will be notified and all privileges suspended. All dues must be current prior to using the golf course.
