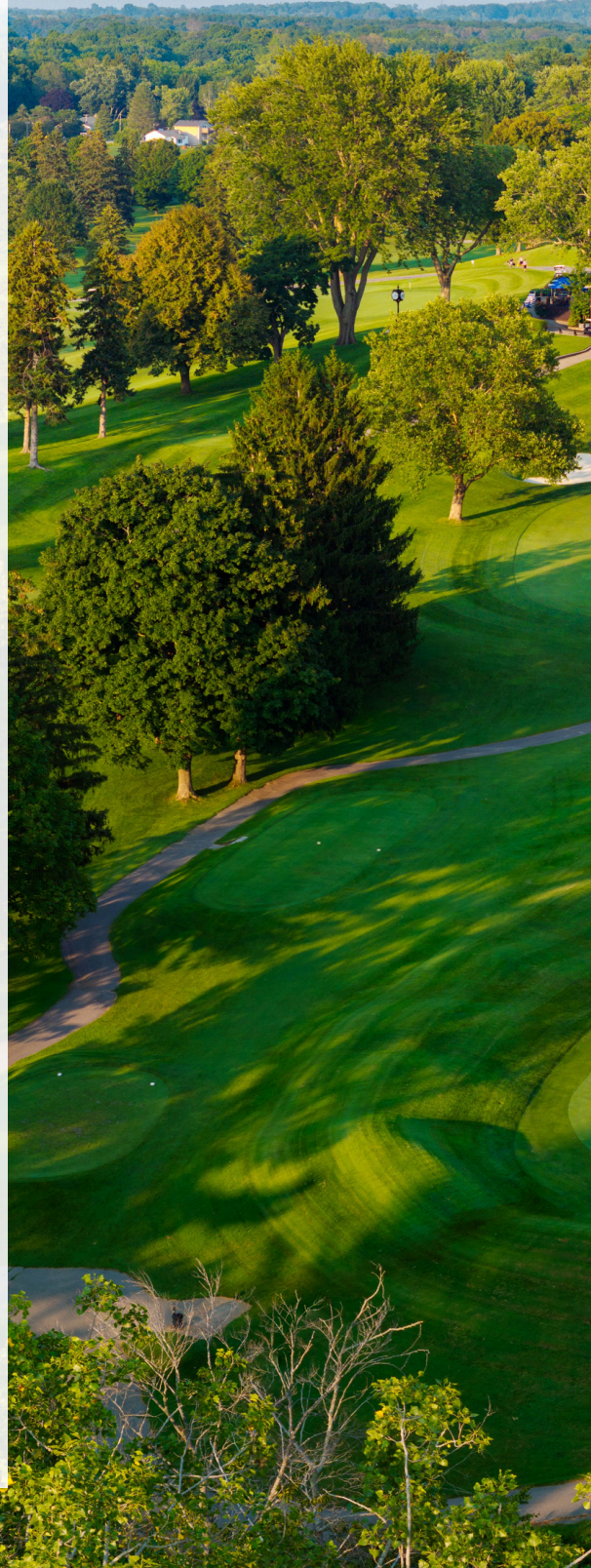

CATEGORY RESTRICTIONS

PRINCIPAL COUPLE: Both Members must reside at the same address, be Principal Members, and spouses.

PRINCIPAL RESTRICTED: Permitted to 25 days of golf, regardless of the numbers of holes played. Member must play after 11:00 am Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays.

PRINCIPAL NON-RESIDENT: a) Member must reside AND have their chief place of business more than 100 km from the club; b) Member must not reside OR work within 100 km of the club for more than 30 days in total in a Membership year; c) Permitted to 25 days of golf, regardless of the number of holes played.

STUDENT: This Member is a student under 25 years of age at a post-secondary institution providing proof of full-time enrollment annually. Member must play after 11:00 am on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays.

JUNIOR: Times restricted until after lottery has been run. Member must play after 9:30 am on Tuesdays and Thursdays and after 2:00 pm on Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays.

SOCIAL LIMITED : Permitted to 15 days of golf regardless of the number of holes played. Member must play after 4:00 pm on Fridays and after 11:00 am on, Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays.
